SUBJECT: FERA SUPPORT FOR NRC LICENSING OF SHOREHAM NUCLEAR STATION

My memorandum to you dated June 1, 1983 (copy enclosed) forwarded copies of the Long Island Lighting Company (LILCO) interim offsite plans for the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station, transmitted to the NRC by LILCO on May 26, 1983. In the memorandum, we asked that you provide the NRC with findings and determinations as to whether these interim plans, along with the LILCO-County plan of October 1982, are adequate and capable of implementation. We asked for your findings by June 23, 1983.

Subsequent to the above (on June 10, 1983), the newly appointed Atomic Safety and Licensing Board issued three orders pertaining to the emergency planning proceedings for Shoreham. One order, entitled "Order Limiting Scope of Submissions" directed the parties to proceed only on the LILCO Transition Plan until a further order was issued. Therefore, per our telecon of June 16, 1983, the memorandum of June 1, 1983 is modified to request your findings and determinations on the LILCO Transition Plan as a first priority. Your findings are still needed by June 23, 1983. We understand that you will provide separate findings on whether the above referenced plan is adequate, whether it is capable of being implemented and whether LILCO has the ability to implement the plan.

We also understand that you will be referring the remainder of the plans, in anticipation of additional rulings by the Board. We will advise you as soon as possible of a scheduled visit for a FERA filing on these other plans.
