On June 23 and 24, 1983 Joseph Halapatz (MtEB-DE) and Dave Wagner (LB#2-DL) met with representatives of Bechtel Power Corporation in San Francisco, California to conduct a GDC-51 compliance review for the above facilities. GDC-51 is concerned with Fracture Prevention of the Containment Pressure. Boundary. A list of attendees for the June 23 and 24 sessions are included as Enclosure 1 and 2 respectively.

During the June session, the review was conducted for Hope Creek. At this meeting Bechtel made available for review the following information:

- a. Penetration list
- Equipment hatch and personnel airlock assembly and door detail drawings
- Containment vessel details of reinforcement at hatches, penetration, torus and vent pipes
- d. Drywell head details at flange
- e. Penetration assembly drawings: flued head details

During the June 24, sessions, the review was conducted for Limerick 1/2. At this meeting, Bechtel made available for review the same information, except for item c, as was made available for Hope Creek.
