
"b. The one year operating time is based on the environmental profiles in the service environment chart (see FSAR Section 3.11 as amended by Amendment [forthcoming; copy

attached)). The basis for these profiles is presented in FSAR Section 6.2.

The service environmental chart conservatively assumes environmental conditions for a period of one year. The one year qualification period has been used as a conservative time period to assure safety systems are able to perform their safety function."




