MEMORANDUM

(Re Contentions on New Hampshire Emergency Response Procedures)

On August 11, 1983, the New England Coalition Against Nuclear Pollution (NECNP) filed contentions addressing the New Hampshire Emergency Response Procedures. The NRC Staff and the Applicants responded on August 26 and August 30 respectively; both assert that implementing procedures for emergency plans are not litigable. They cite Louisiana Power & Light Co. (Waterford Steam Electric Station, Unit 3), ALAB-732, 17 NRC \_\_\_\_ (slip op. at 53-54, June 29, 1983).

The Board hereby provides NECNP the opportunity to respond to the Applicants' and the Staff's arguments, provided such response is filed within ten days after issuance of this Memorandum.
