Inspection Summary

Inspection on November 11, 1983 and January 17, 1984 (Report No. 50-255/83-27

Areas Inspected: Routine announced inspection by Region III inspector of calculations concerning adequacy of fan coolers for the engineered safeguards room as referened in LER 83-007. This inspection involved a total of 12 inspector-hours at the licensee's office by one NRC inspector. Results: No items of noncompliance or deviations were identified.

2. Functional or Program Areas Inspected

As detailed in LER 83-007 the Engineered Safeguards Room Air Cooler must be adequate to maintain an air temperature of less than $135^{\circ}(F)$ with only one of the two fans operating.

The purpose of calculation P-SW5-831003 was to establish heat removal capacity of the cooler with only one fan operational. The purpose of calculation E-PAL-83-030 was to establish the heat loss of the various equipment in the room. Both of these calculations were reviewed by the inspector and appear to be essentially correct.

No deviations or violations were identified.
