
Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio, at its session on January 11, 1984, approved a resolution entitled:

Expressing Council's dissatisfaction over NRC's failure to require a third party independent review of the Zimmer Nuclear Power Station.

WHEREAS, in CG&F's "Course of Action" and its "Plan to Verify Quality of Construction," the Bechtel Corporation is charged with conducting a partial hardware review; and

WHEREAS, a partial review is insufficient and a complete review by an independent third party is needed, particularly where Bechtel's review presents at least, the appearance of a direct conflict of interest; and

WHEREAS, Council and this community cannot properly address the cost issues presented by the Zimmer facility unless we are made fully aware of the hardware and safety problems at the Zimmer Station; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That Council hereby expresses its dissatisfaction over NRC's failure to require a complete hardware review by an independent third party of the Zimmer Nuclear Power Station.

Section 2. That this resolution be spread upon the minutes of Council, and that copies be sent to Representatives Gradison and Luken; Senators Glenn and Metzenbaum; Governor Richard Celeste; and Representative Morris Udall.
