This is an update to a previous report submitted on March 30, 1983, for the following event. From February 22, 1983, to March 16, 1983, numerous fire rated seals were opened to perform planned maintenance activities. Voluntary entry into Action (a) of Technical Specification 3.7.7 was made. The purpose of this update is to provide a revised estimated completion date for fire rated seals that have not been restored. The penetrations affected are listed on the attached page.

This condition has no affect on the health and safety of the public and does not constitute a threat to plant safety. The seals were opened to perform planned maintenance activities. An hourly fire watch is being conducted and will be maintained until work is complete. Estimated completion date for the remainder of the work tasks is now October 15, 1983. This is a Special Report submitted pursuant to Technical Specification 6.9.2.
