Subject: IE Bulletin 83-07: Apparently Fraudulent Product Sold By Ray Miller Inc.

Dear Mr. Collins:

Pursuant to IE Bulletin 83-07 directive, an investigation was conducted at Cooper Nuclear Station to determine the status of Ray Miller material purchased by the facility. The following is presented for your review:

 A comparison between Attachment 1 and 2 of the IE Bulletin 83-07 and the CNS Vendor Code Book to determine what vendors were included in both lists was performed.

Results

Forty-six (46) vendors listed in the IE Bulletin were listed in the CNS Vendor Code Book.

Determined if any of the vendors indicated in the results of #1 above were issued a purchase order from CNS.

Results

A review of all CNS purchase orders are located on film, in the CNS Purchase Order History file and in the Purchase Order files, indicated that twelve (12) vendors were issued Purchase Orders from CNS.

3. Determine if any of the twelve vendors noted above supplied CNS with material from Ray Miller Inc.

Results

Review of all the P.O.'s issued to these vendors indicated that $\underline{\text{NO}}$ Ray Miller Inc. material was purchased.

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4. Determine if any vendors not listed in Attachments 1 and 2 of IEB #83-07 have supplied Ray Miller Inc. material.

Results

- A. As noted in references 2 and 3 on the prior page, a search of the computer Vendor Code was performed and revealed that Ray Miller Inc. had supplied piping and fittings to Midco Supply Company of Omaha, who in turn furnished this material to NPPD, through a contractor, under Contract E69-5 "Shop Fabricated Tanks". Specifically, this material was furnished for Tank #7 "Waste Sludge" and Tank #13 "Backwash Condensate Transfer". The material was received by CNS between the time period of O tober 1970 through May 1971. These tanks, by contract, are designated Class I. Our records show that these tanks were shop fabricated and hydro tested prior to shipment to the site. This would indicate that the material in question was used for an addition to the tank, such as the Sparger System, which does not fit the classification of Essential.
- Review of CNS Document Contro' films, CNS P.O. files and CNS Purchase Order History File (P. 4F) indicated that Ray Miller Inc. had supplied one (1) piece of Cl. ss IV 6" Sch. 40 welded pipe (carpenter 20 type) to Great Plain: Ind. Supply of Omaha, who in turn supplied this material to Co, through a contractor (Jelco. Inc.) under Contract #E69-4 "Mechanical Piping, Equipment and Erection". The material was received at CNS on December 4, 1970. The only system at CNS using Carpenter 20 piping is the water treatment system which is a Non-Essential system.

Conclusion

Review of CNS Purchase Orders concerning vendors listed in Attachments 1 and 2 of IE Bulletin 83-07 indicates that no Ray Miller Inc. material was purchased by CNS, from the time period of 1975 through 1983. It should also be noted that the only material used at CNS from Ray Miller Inc. was supplied in 1970 and 1971 and it was used on Non-Essential systems.

The investigation and report preparation for this Bulletin took approximately 50 hours.
