SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR NRR ASSISTANCE FOR SITE VISITS
RE: TRUCK BOMB THREAT CONTRACT

As you know, NRR has been requested by NMSS in a memorandum dated December 23, 1983, see Enclosure 1, to coordinate the licensee interface with RES as necessary to accomplish subject task. The site selection process for the power reactors (Turkey Point and Quad Cities) was completed prior to receipt of subject memorandum and independent of NRR input. This RES project has now been expanded upon to include certain non-power reactors.

RES has contracted with Sandia National Laboratory to conduct the project. Sandia in turn, has requested permission to visit the selected plants as part of the contract. Personnel from the Division of Facility Operations, RES, contacted the cognizant PM's directly and understood as a result of those discussions that they could proceed with making site visit arrangements, see Enclosure 2, this has resulted in confusion for all parties involved. Had SSPB been informed of the site visit requirements, the ensuing problems of finalizing arrangements for site visits and obtaining site drawings could have been avoided.

The following corrective actions have been taken as a result of above incident:

Robert Burnett, NMSS was reminded of the procedures for coordinating such requests with DL. He has agreed to take corrective actions with RES and to coordinate such requests through SSPB in the future. Additionally, he has agreed to present a briefing on the RES project at the NRR/NMSS safeguards meeting scheduled for January 24, 1984.
