A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN LUIS OBISPO REQUESTING THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION DEFER RELICENSING OF DIABLO CANYON POWER PLANT UNTIL REVERIFICATION PROGRAM AND SAFETY STUDIES ARE COMPLETED

WHEREAS the Diablo Canyon power plant has been the subject of a reverification analysis of its seismic safety as required by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC); and

WHEREAS the NRC recently adopted a licensing schedule which permits restoration of the plant's license and fuel loading before the reverification program is completed, before the results are analyzed, and before any corrective action called for in that program, if any, can be implemented; and

WHEREAS the licensing schedule for the plant also has no provision for the completion of studies of three plant safety systems ordered by the NRC, nor for the analysis of those studies, nor for the implementation of their recommendations;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Luis Obispo urges, in the interest of the public's health and safety, that licensing, fuel loading or operation of the Diablo Canyon power plant be deferred until the reverification program and safety studies commissioned by the NRC are finished; the plant is proven to be safe; and all plant modifications to safety related structures, systems, and components are completed.
