DOCKETS 50-266 AND 50-301 SITE VISIT FOR DISCUSSIONS ON INSERVICE INSPECTION POINT BEACH NUCLEAR PLANT, UNITS 1 AND 2

Your letter dated August 24, 1983 requested a three-day site visit during the week of September 11, 1983 to discuss a number of issues regarding the inservice testing (IST) program for the Point Beach Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2. A listing of additional information needed to complete your review and to be discussed at this meeting was enclosed with your letter.

As discussed by telephone with Mr. Colburn of your staff, because of outage planning and preparations for a full-scale emergency preparedness exercise we were unable to accommodate a site visit in this time frame. We propose instead that your site visit be scheduled for the last week in October or the first week in November. If these dates are not suitable for your personnel, perhaps some other arrangements involving a conference telephone call or a trip to Bethesda by Wisconsin Electric personnel can be arranged. We will work with Mr. Colburn of your staff to finalize acceptable arrangements.
