SUPPLEMENTAL RESPONSE TO IE BULLETIN 83-03

Dear Mr. O'Reilly:

A review of Carolina Power & Light Company's responses to IE Bulletin 83-03 dated June 8, 1933 (Serial No. BSEP/83-1627), and December 13, 1983 (Serial No. BSEP/83-3890), revealed a potential conflict in the periodicity of the committed valve inspection program. To avoid confusion in the future, CP&L commits to inspecting the valve internals to verify operability on a two-valve-per-year periodicity (one diesel). This inspection has already been incorporated in plant procedure MI-10-521I.
