By letter dated January 5, 1984, you referred to our letter dated December 5, 1983, to Mr. Joseph Pandy, Jr. informing him of our initial finding regarding no significant antitrust changes for Unit 1 of the Perry Nuclear Plant. You requested a 30 day extension, presumably from the January 5, 1984 date, in which to respond to the Federal Register notice of the initial finding (Fed. Reg. 52992, mated Nov. 23, 1983).

Your request for extension is granted. If you decide to request a reevaluation of the finding, you should provide full particulars with documentation, not merely allegations, addressing specifically in what ways the significant changes are attributable to the applicant(s), their antitrust implications, and how the changes would likely warrant a Commission remedy.
