This acknowledges receipt of your letter dated February 15, 1995, in which you requested an extension until March 15, 1995, to respond to the subject letter and for me to confirm that licensees are not required to demonstrate compliance with Positions 9 and 10 of the NRC staff's technical position of fire protection for fuel cycle facilities.

As discussed with you on February 14, 1995, recipients of the subject letter are not required to demonstrate compliance with Positions 9 and 10 and the purpose of the subject letter is to perform a survey of fire protection programs currently in place at licensed fuel cycle facilities.

Your request for an extension until March 15, 1995, to respond to the subject letter is granted.
