MEETING SUMMARY OF MEETING WITH GSU TO DISCUSS CLASS 9 ACCIDENT

The meeting was held at Bethesda, Maryland on August 25, 1983 to discuss the requirements for an analysis of severe accidents to be provided by the applicant. Attachment 1 is a list of participants at this meeting. Section 7.1.2 of the DES/FES requires an analysis of severe accidents by the applicant and an independent analysis of these accidents by the NRC staff. The discussion centered about various means by which GSU could satisfy the NRC Commission's Statement of Interim Policy dated June 13, 1980. This statement said that "Environmental Reports submitted by applicants for construction permits and for operating licenses on or after July 1, 1980 should include a discussion of the environmental risks associated with accidents that follow the guidance given herein." GSU will commit in the near future to submit the required analysis and will discuss further with the staff the content, from and basis for their submittal.
