Dear Mr. Schwencer:

The reference 2 telecon informed us of the Assistant Directors' decision made pursuant to the reference 1 meeting. The decision was that the appeal was denied and that a second isolation valve is required in the lines to and from the hydrogen recombiner. The reference 2 telecon further informed us that this item would be changed from an Outstanding Issue to a License Condition with the provision that the additional valves be added before starting up after the first refueling outage.

Philadelphia Electric Company will provide a second isolation valve in the lines to and from the hydrogen recombiner prior to starting up after the first refueling outage. This commitment will be placed into the FSAR in the revision scheduled for November.
