I am responding to a concern that you provided to us on July 12, 1991, alleging that on July 3 or 4, while Unit 2 was in heatup, a surveillance test (via SP 2402P) for ESFAS/RPS was performed unusually fast (2 1/2 hours verses normal 5-6 hours typically required), and that you believe that the shift was pushing for Mode 3, and something could have been missed.

We have inspected this incident and found your concern to be unsubstantiated. Our detailed findings will be documented in NRC Inspection Report 50-336/91-18, a copy of which will be forwarded to you under separate cover.
