SUBJECT: TRANSPORTATION OF AMERICIUM-241 CONTAMINATED EQUIPMENT

This is to provide an update on the americium-241 contaminated equipment that was shipped from E.A.D. Metallurgical (a State-licensed smoke-detector manufacturer in New York) through Laredo. Texas, with final destination to have been Monterrey, Mexico. The contaminated material is currently still impounded by the Texas Bureau of Radiation Control in an isolated corner of a warehouse in Laredo, Texas.

Since the issuance of the order impounding the shipment on July 1, 1983, several meetings have been conducted with representatives from the Department of Transportation, the Texas Bureau of Radiation Control, E.A.D. Metallurgical, and the NRC Office of State Programs.

To date, the issue remains of how to repackage and transfer the equipment to appropriate facilities in Mexico.

The State and Federal agencies involved are continuing their investigations of the incident and attempting to resolve the issue with E.A.D. officials. There has been media interest concerning the incident.
