RESPONSE PARTLY OPPOSING APPLICANTS: PROPOSED SCHEDULE REVISION OF 9.12.83 by Wells Eddleman

Applicants blithely assert that I am not prejudiced by their proposed schedule revisions; they have never consulted me about them, before or after filing their motion. Since Applicants proposed November 11, 1983 as the last day for discovery responses, but October 14 as the last day for discovery requests, I believe October 21 (21 days before November 11) is a more appropriate cutoff date for discovery requests on contentions admitted August 18. (While in the past they have grumbled about my not doing discovery fast enough, here they seek to use my speed of me in filing against me. I note that their own discovery wasn't filed for nearly a month after the relevant contentions were admitted.) The date of October 21 is more consistent with my heavy workload in this case.

For contentions timely filed and admitted 9/22/82, there is no reason to alter the testimony filing date of December 9, except perhaps for 29, 37B and Joint II. The original schedule has been adhered to on the other "old" (9/22/82 admitted) contentions. Applicants are seeking

more time because they can use it, not because they need it.

For the above reasons the above modifications to the proposed schedule should be made.
