Pursuant to the Freedom on Information Act (5 U.S.C. § 552) and the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") regulations (10 C.F.R. Part 9, Subpart A), please provide copies of records1/pertaining to the following:

- 1. Any and all records prepared by or supplied to the NRC Staff, and/or its consultants or contractors, as part of the Diagnostic Evaluation Team ("DET") inspection conducted at Houston Lighting & Power Company's ("HL&P's") South Texas Project ("STP"), including but not limited to:
 - a. Records regarding the decision to conduct the DET inspection;
 - b. Records associated with activities conducted in preparation for the DET inspection, during the DET inspection, or after the DET inspection including the development of the DET inspection report;

Reference to the term "records" means any and all printed or written materials regardless of form or characteristic, including but not limited to reports, memoranda, correspondence, statements, studies, spreadsheets, charts, graphs, agendas, outlines, summaries, notes, notebooks, telephone conversation logs, or meeting minutes, as well as any and all sound recordings, videotapes, computer discs, or photographs. See also 10 C.F.R. § 9.13.

I would appreciate the handling of this request as quickly as possible, and look forward to hearing from you within 10 days as required by law. Finally, please advise me of the costs involved in obtaining these records if such costs are estimated to exceed \$500.00.

Dear Mr. Taylor:

On March 29, 1993, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) sent a Diagnostic Evaluation Team to the South Texas Nuclear Project to begin an evaluation of the project's management, personnel, and organizational effectiveness. The nuclear facility had been exhibiting a distinct decline in operating performance and regulatory compliance during the last year. The City of Austin is requesting your assistance in monitoring this review.

Austin owns a 16% share of the South Texas Nuclear Project along with Houston Lighting and Power Company (30.8%), Central Power and Light Company (25.2%), and City Public Service of San Antonio (28%).

The City of Austin is strongly committed to assuring the safety of the South Texas Nuclear Project and in improving its operational performance. The project has always been a major concern for the citizens of Austin. On March 18, 1993, the Austin City Council approved a resolution directing the City Manager to take all appropriate actions to assure a thorough investigation of safety issues at the South Texas Nuclear Project, including communication with Federal authorities to express the City's interest in safety at the project.

The evaluation of the project could also have major implications for the entire nuclear power industry as well as the nation's energy policy. Your assistance in monitoring the regulatory performance of the South Texas Nuclear Project and the Diagnostic Evaluation Team analysis in particular would be greatly appreciated.

Dear Dr. Barnett:

I appreciate the interest that you have expressed about the NRC's ongoing Diagnostic Evaluation of the South Texas Project. The Diagnostic Evaluation will provide an independent assessment of Houston Lighting and Power Company safety performance at South Texas, and the results of this effort will supplement information from the NRC's Systematic Assessment of Licensee Performance (SALP) and Performance Indicator programs, and other assessment data.

My decision to conduct a Diagnostic Evaluation at South Texas resulted from a January 1993 meeting of NRC senior managers, where a detailed review of the regulatory and safety performance history of the South Texas Project, as well as other licensed nuclear facilities, was conducted. During these discussions, it was concluded that additional information regarding South Texas would be needed for NRC senior management to more fully evaluate overall plant performance.

At this time the Diagnostic Evaluation Team (DET) has completed the onsite evaluation phase of its review. The team's plan calls for their written report to be issued around the middle of June 1993. The results of the South Texas Project evaluation will therefore be available for consideration by NRC senior management when they meet again in June 1993. At that time, they will review the recent regulatory and safety performance history of South Texas, as well as other licensed nuclear facilities.

As you know, on April 7, 1993, during the initial onsite evaluation period, the DET manager met with the City of Austin Utility Council and provided an overview of the Diagnostic Evaluation process and the team's evaluation plan. At this meeting, he indicated that the NRC would conduct a public meeting in the vicinity of the South Texas Project to discuss the team's results after issuance of their report.
