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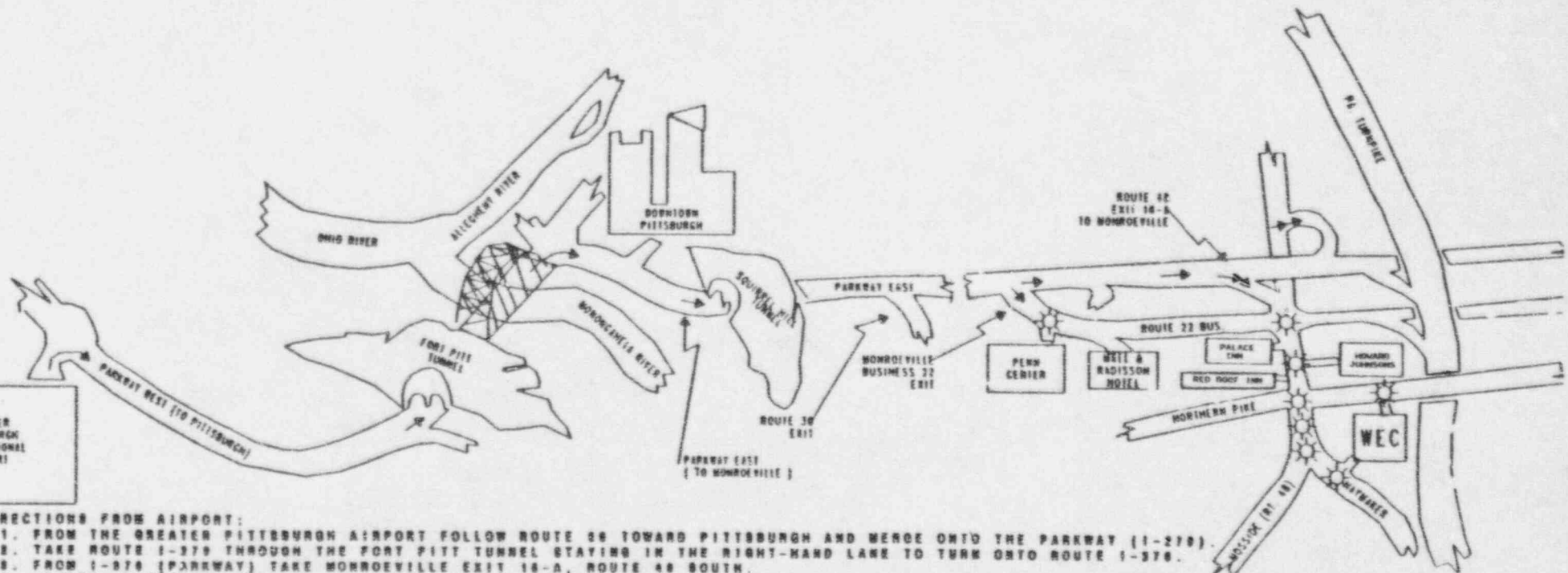

DIRECTIONS FROM AIRPORT:

1. FROM THE GREATER PITTSBURGH AIRPORT FOLLOW ROUTE 30 TOWARD PITTSBURGH AND MERGE ONTO THE PARKWAY (I-270).
2. TAKE ROUTE 1-370 THROUGH THE FORT PITT TUNNEL STAYING IN THE RIGHT-HAND LANE TO TURN ONTO ROUTE 1-370.
3. FROM 1-370 (PARKWAY) TAKE MONROEVILLE EXIT 18-A, ROUTE 48 SOUTH.
4. HOWARD JOHNSON'S, HOLIDAY INN, ENJOY INN, RED ROOF INN ARE ON ROUTE 48.
5. FOR THE RADISSON, TURN RIGHT AT FIRST TRAFFIC LIGHT ON ROUTE 48, ONTO WM. PENN HIGHWAY (BUSINESS ROUTE 22).
6. KEEP TO THE LEFT THRU-LANE AND TURN LEFT AFTER ABOUT 7 LIGHTS ONE LIGHT AFTER THE ZATRE STORE'S LIGHT OR USE THE MALL ENTRANCE ON THE RIGHT ABOUT 1/2 MILE FURTHER DOWN.
