ORDER FOR FILING CROSS-EXAMINATION PLANS

Pursuant to our Order Confirming Schedule Change (unpublished) of January 31, 1984 all parties are to file cross-examination plans on or before March 16, 1984. This Order describes the information the Board wishes to see in each cross-examination plan (hereinafter "plan").

Each party who intends to cross-examine any witness for whom written testimony has been filed shall file with the Board a plan in outline form on or before March 16, 1984. The plan shall be sufficient to inform the Board of the purposes and objectives of such cross-examination. Such plan shall specify any affirmative evidence the cross-examiner intends to produce during the cross-examination as well as specific portions of the direct testimony which the cross-examiner intends to discredit.


