On an unrelated matter, the Board in a recent Memorandum and Order made comments regarding the timeliness of CBG's complaint about the timeliness of UCLA's security plan in the context of due date for timely renewal application. To set the record straight, the Board should be advised that CBG only recently learned of the untimeliness of the UCIA submission of its security plan. CBG did not know four years ago, when the rest of the application was publicly submitted, that the security plan was untimely filed, for to obvious reason that the security plan was not publicly submitted, being protected safeguards information. Only one member of CBG's team to date has even seen the plan, and that was only last week. CBG learned of the untimeliness of its filing only through a recent reference to its date of filing contained in a recent public Staff document.
