## Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted under the Resident Inspection Program - Operations by Mr. W. S. Schum and Ms. K. A. Whittlesey of this office during the period November 1 - 30, 1983, of activities authorized by NRC Construction Permit No. CPPR 147, for the Wolf Creek Generating Station and to the discussion of our findings with Messrs. F. T. Rhodes, R. Glover, and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during the inspection included site tours, followup on previous inspection findings, review of procedures, and observation of startup activities. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. The inspection findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

During this inspection, it was found that certain of your activities appeared to deviate from commitments made to the NRC. This item and reference to the commitment are identified in the enclosed Notice of Deviation. You are requested to respond to this deviation in writing. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Deviation enclosed with this letter.

In addition, it was found that certain of your activities were in violation of NRC requirements. Consequently, you are required to respond to these violations, in writing, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2.201 of the NRC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations. Your response should be based on the specifics contained in the Notice of Violation enclosed with this letter.
