This is in response to your February 8, 1984 letter to Mr. James G. Keppler, Regional Administrator, requesting that we update and reissue Mr. Keppler's April 10, 1980 letter describing NRC's role in a radiological emergency at the Callaway Plant.

The NRC plans to respond to all significant incidents at power reactors and other licensed facilities as stated in NUREG 0728, NRC Incident Response Flan; MUREG-0845, Agency Procedures for the NRC Incident Response Plan; and the NRC Region III Emergency Response Implementing Procedures. The nature of our response will be primarily one of monitoring licensee actions rather than providing assistance and resources. Your Radiological Emergency Response plan should recognize that we must be notified promptly following an incident, but we should not be relied upon for assistance in the same sense as other agencies, e.g., the U.S. Department of Energy.
