NOTICE OF VIOLATION

Carolina Power and Light Company  
Brunswick 1 and 2

As a result of the special inspection conducted on July 7, 1983, and in accordance with the NRC Enforcement Policy, 47 FR 9987 (March 9, 1982), the following violation was identified.

Amendments 45 and 21 to License Nos. DPR-62 and DPR-71 respectively, require the licensee to comply with the provisions of its Physical Security Plan, Revision 7, dated February 26, 1982.

Paragraph 3.2.1.4 of the Physical Security Plan requires access to the protected area to be controlled by security personnel. Security personnel are required to issue badges and perform positive identification of the individual to whom the badge is issued.

Paragraph 3.2.1.5 of the Physical Security Plan, under the heading of "Search Program," requires all personnel entering the protected area to be searched utilizing a metal and explosive detector.

Contrary to the above, on June 30, 1983, an authorized licensee employee entered the protected area through gate No. 1 without a badge and without being physically searched or searched by a metal and explosive detector.

This is a Severity Level III Violation (Supplement III ).

Pursuant to the provisions of 10 CFR 2.201, you are hereby required to submit to this office within thirty days of the date of this Notice, a written statement or explanation in reply, including: (1) admissions or denial of the alleged violation; (2) the reasons for the violation if admitted; (3) the corrective steps which have been taken and the results achieved; (4) corrective steps which will be taken to avoid further violations; and (5) the date when full compliance will be achieved. Consideration may be given to extending your response time for good cause shown.
