SUBJECT: SERIOUS PERSONNEL INJURY HEART ATTACK

On the morning of Monday, October 3, 1983, licensee personnel informed Region V personnel that an employee had suffered an apparent heart attack at 9:10 a.m. PST while at work. Reportedly, the person had been taken to a local hospital for two or three days.

The licensee made a prompt telephone report at 10:00 a.m. on October 3, 1983, pursuant to Technical Specification requirements.

Neither the licensee nor the NRC plans to issue a news release. Region V (San Francisco) received notification of this occurrence from the licensee at about 10:00 a.m. on October 3, 1983. This information is current as of 10:00 a.m. October 3, 1983.
