ORDERED


1. That Contention 2 is reworded as follows:


The probability of failure of the Old River Control Structure is sufficiently high that the consequences of operating the River Bend Station following such failure must be considered. Applicants have not considered the public health, safety, and


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environmental impacts of further facility operation under altered river flow and salinity conditions in the event of failure.

2. That, in the interest of expediting all future objections, motions and other requests by any party for action by this Board, the moving party shall consult with all other parties and include a representation as to each other party's position on the action requested.
