MEMORANDUM AND ORDER (Reopening of Mosbaugh Deposition)

On March 6, 1995, Georgia Power Company, et al., (Georgia Power) filed a "Motion to Reconvene Deposition of Allen Mosbaugh [Intervenor]" to which it attached an "In camera Memorandum In Support of Motion to Reconvene Deposition of Allen Mosbaugh." See 10 CFR §§ 2.740a, 2.718(d)-(f), 2.740(c),(d). The reason provided for making the Memorandum in camera is that it contains cross-examination materials that have an important element of surprise. After our review of these materials, we agree

with this reasoning and will keep the materials in camera until after they are disclosed in the course of cross-examination.

Because the support for this motion is filed in camera, Intervenor is unable to file a meaningful response at this time. Accordingly, we have reviewed this motion without receiving a response from Intervenor. We find that, based on the record of this case, Georgia Power has substantiated its motion to reconvene the deposition of Allen Mosbaugh. We therefore shall order the reconvened deposition to be conducted on March 15 or March 16, as the parties may arrange. The scope of the deposition shall be limited to the matters raised in the in camera submission or reasonably related to that submission. Matters going beyond the rermissible scope may not be used at the hearing.

Unless directed otherwise by Georgia Power, we shall keep its submission in camera. However, Georgia Power's use of the reopened portion of the deposition at the hearing will depend on its ability to demonstrate, in the face of arguments of Intervenor, that it had adequate grounds for reopening the deposition or that the use of the reopened deposition is necessary for an adequate record in this case.

ORDER

For all the foregoing reasons and upon consideration of the entire record in this matter, it is this 7th day of March, 1995, ORDERED, that:

The deposition of Allen Mosbaugh shall be reconvened on March 15 or 16 at a place that the parties shall agree. The parties may change the date for this deposition by agreement.
