I refer to your letter dated June 24, 1994, addressed to Dr. René Dietrich and myself. In said letter, you implied that we had not submitted a quality management program, as of that date. Since we have not received a reply to our letter, we need to advice you again that, despite the fact that we do not use iodine I-125 or I-131 in any quantity, we did submit a QMP as part of our license renewal submitted in November, 1993.

Since that time, we have modified the QMP that we submitted then, so I am enclosing a copy of the revised program which we intend to use in the event that we start using radioiodine.
