This refers to the special training assessment conducted by Mr. C. W. Hehl of this office on August 2-5, 1983, of activities authorized by NRC Operating License Nos. DPR-57 and NPF-5 for the Hatch facility. Our preliminary findings were discussed with Mr. H. Nix, Site General Manager, at the conclusion of the assessment.

Areas examined during this assessment and our findings are discussed in the enclosed report. Within these areas, the assessment consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors.

The results of this assessment indicate substantial improvements in the amount and quality of training being provided to the personnel at Hatch Nuclear Station. Although certain weaknesses in some areas of training were identified; in general, the training program was determined to be above average. Management commitment to providing an exemplary program was evident. Plans for additional enhancements to the program should result in a commendable program.

Within the scope of this assessment, no violations or deviations were disclosed.
