Gentlemen:

Thank you for your letter of November 28, 1983, in response to our letter and Notice of Violation dated November 4, 1983. We have reviewed your reply and find it responsive to the concerns raised in our Notice of Violation. It is noted, however, that your response does contain an error. In the second paragraph on page 2 of your response it is stated that the item (NRMCA certificate) was an unresolved item in the NRC inspection conducted October 3-5, 1983. Although it is correct that the question of an NRMCA certificate was at onetime an unresolved item (NRC Inspection Report 83-24), it was upgraded to a violation in NRC Inspection Report 83-26 as was discussed with your Mr. Brey in a telephone conversation on February 13, 1984. NRC Inspection Report 83-26 was conducted October 3-5, 1983. Since the error is not germane to your corrective action, no additional response is required. We will review the implementation of your corrective actions during a future inspection to determine that full compliance has been achieved and will be maintained.
