
1. I am employed by Bechtel Power Corporation (Bechtel) and am currently assigned as Piping Group Supervisor of the Onsite Project Engineering Group (OPEG) located at the Diablo Canyon nuclear power project near Avila Beach, California. From the Spring of 1982 until November, 1983, I was assigned as the large bore Pipe Support Group Leader of the Diablo Canyon Project engineering team in San Francisco, California.

2. Mr. Stokes alleges that during the period of his employment at OPEG I was sent to the Diablo Canyon jobsite for the purpose of explaining the basis and use of PGandE drawing 049243 to the small bore pipe support group.
3. At no time was I ever requested to, nor did I ever go to, the Diablo Canyon jobsite to explain PGandE's drawing 049243 or any other document of procedure to the small bore pipe support group.
4. I did, however, ask Mr. Charles Magee to make a trip to the jobsite in February 1983, to explain recent changes to Drawing 049243. Mr. Magee was an agency engineer knowledgeable about Drawing 049243 and was, at that time, working in my large bore pipe support group. He was not sent to explain the conservatisms in Drawing 049243 or to defend the basis for its development as alleged by Mr. Stokes. While Mr. Magee was generally knowledgeable in the application of 049243, he was not authorized to provide interpretations of small bore piping design criteria or to establish small bore support design criteria or policy.
