## Meeting Summary:

Meeting Conducted September 8, 1983 (Report 50-445/83-37; 50-446/83-19) Areas Inspected: This routine, announced meeting and emergency response facility tour involved approximately 12 inspector-hours by two NRC representatives. This included: discussions with licensee management concerning the emergency preparedness appraisal, and a brief tour and inspection of emergency response facilities equipment and instrumentation to determine the applicant's state of preparation for the emergency preparedness appraisal scheduled to begin on September 26, 1983.
