Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Messrs. R. P. Mullikin and W. F. Smith during the period June 25-29, 1990, of activities authorized by NRC Operating Licenses DPR-51 and NPF-6 for Arkansas Nuclear One. Units 1 and 2, and to the discussion of our findings with Mr. E. C. Ewing and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

The area examined was the review of licensee event reports (LERs). Within this area, the inspection consisted of selective examination of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspectors. The findings are documented in the enclosed inspection report.

Paragraph 2.2 of the enclosed inspection report identifies a number of LERs that relate to seismic issues identified by you which document conditions that have existed from initial construction. We recognize that your actions relative to the identification and resolution of these seismic issues have resulted from earlier NRC regulatory actions that include inspection and Enforcement Bulletins (IEBs) 79-02 and 79-14, the Safety System Functional Inspection (NRC Inspection Report 50-313/86-01), the reinspection of IEBs 79-02 and 79-14 (NRC Inspection Report 50-313/89-200), the Diagnostic Evaluation Team Inspection, and previous escalated enforcement action (EA 88-284) relative to your corrective action program. Based on the above factors and the extensive corrective actions AP&L has implemented. NRC does not consider further enforcement action warranted. Additionally, it is anticipated that seismic issues may continue to be identified from your initiatives such as the isometric update project and other design basis-related programs. It remains AP&L's responsibility to continue to ensure that timely identification, evaluation for operability, corrective action, and reporting is performed in accordance with regulatory requirements.

As a result of this inspection, and as documented in paragraph 2.2 of the enclosed inspection report, it is our understanding that you have committed to complete a review of your internal procedures for assessing and reporting the safety significance of an event, including consideration of the status and operability of other compensating support equipment. Please contact Mr. S. J. Collins of this office within 10 days of the date of this letter should your understanding of this commitment differ from ours.
