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Subject: NRC INSPECTION OF PALO VERDE UNITS 1, 2 AND 3

This letter refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. W. TenBrook on May 20-28, 1991. The inspection included a review of activities authorized for Palo Verde Nuclear Generating Station, Units One, Two and Three. At the conclusion of the inspection, our findings were discussed with those members of your staff identified in the enclosed report.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the enclosed inspection report. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Section 3 of the report discusses strontium-89 and strontium-90 measurement disagreements between your laboratories, your quality assurance sample vendor, and the NRC. We are concerned about these disagreements as they affect the amount of radioactive material permitted in the reactor coolant. These inconsistencies have also been noted in prior inspections. We request that you respond to this letter within sixty days, specifically addressing what corrective actions you will take to assure consistent results.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified within the scope of this inspection.

In accordance with 10 CFR 2.790(a), a copy of this letter and the enclosure will be placed in the NRC Public Document Room.

Should you have any questions concerning this inspection, we will be glad to discuss them with you.
