Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Epstein of this office on October 11, 1973 at Quakana, Pennsylvania of activities authorized by AEC License No. 37-11307-02 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Epstein with Mr. Moslak of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection, and to a subsequent telephone discussion between Dr. Witt and Mr. Epstein on October 15, 1973.

The inspection was an examination of activities conducted under your license as they relate to radiation safety and to compliance with the Commission's rules and regulations and the conditions of your license. The inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, measurements made by the inspector, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you had taken to correct the violations brought to your attention in a letter dated May 31, 1973 following our last inspection. We have no further questions regarding these matters.

Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or safety items were observed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the AEC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you make a written application within 20 days to this office to withhold such information from public disclosure. Any such application must include a full statement of the reasons on the basis of which it is claimed that the information is proprietary, and should be prepared so that proprietary information identified in the application is contained in a separate part of the document. If we do not hear from you in this regard within the specified period, the report will be placed in the Public Document Room.
