Subject: DISCOVERY OF SPENT RADIOPHARMACEUTICAL GENERATOR IN MARYLAND

At 1:00 p.m. on November 22, 1983, Region I received a report from the State of Maryland that a private citizen had found a spent molybdenum-99/technetium-99m generator by the side of I-495 near the Maryland side of the Cabin John bridge at 10:30 a.m. that morning. Two Maryland state troopers responded to the citizen's call to the police. The New England Nuclear Corporation generator dates from 1979. A representative of the National Institutes of Health (NIH) Radiation Safety Staff responded at Maryland's request and confirmed that no radiation or radioactive material were present. Several people, however, including the state troopers, were taken to the National Naval Medical Center complaining of illness. Several fire trucks and the press responded, a perimeter was roped off, and I-495 was closed for a time before the generator was confirmed to be non-radioactive and taken to NIH. Neither the shipper nor the carrier have been identified at this time.

This incident has already received considerable media coverage in the District of Columbia area. Region I plans no further action as Maryland is an agreement state. Region I will maintain contact with the State of Maryland.
