


Dear Ed:

In response to your letter to Floyd Jackson on June 28, 1978 requesting additional fencing and dust suppression at the FAP Mill and tailings area, we propose the following action:

- 1- The existing four strand barbed wire fence that follows the boundry of the restricted area will be replaced with a woven wire sheep fence. The woven wire fence will be approximately 39" high with one strand of barbed wire 6" above the top of the woven wire. The fence will follow the boundry of the enlarged restricted area as you suggested in a recent telephone call with Floyd Jackson. Fence construction will begin as soon as the materials are acquired.
- 2- A chemical binding agent will be applied to the loose, dry areas of the tailings pile in order to suppress blowing of the tailings outside of the restricted area. We anticipate that the materials can be purchased and the application arrangements can be made by August 15, 1978.

These measures should be sufficient to meet the objectives that you mentioned in your letter. Contact me or Floyd Jackson if you have questions concerning this proposal.
