Haddam Neck Plant Steam Generator Tube Deformation

The purpose of this letter is for Connecticut Yankee Atomic Power Company (CYAPCO) to submit proprietary and non-proprietary versions of information previously submitted to the NRC Staff.

In a letter dated March 14, 1995⁽¹⁾, CYAPCO provided the Staff with the results of an investigation conducted to address the potential for the bowing and burst of plugged steam generator (SG) tubes at the Haddam Neck Plant. The results were submitted as attachments to the March 14, 1995, letter. Attachment 1 provided the results of SG tube eddy current data reanalysis. Attachment 2 provided the engineering evaluation performed by Westinghouse of burst/plugged tube(s) at the Haddam Neck Plant.

Although Attachment 2 contained information proprietary to Westinghouse Electric Corporation, the request to withhold the information from public disclosure was not accompanied with proprietary and non-proprietary versions of the information, an affidavit, proprietary information notice and copyright notice. The NRC Staff agreed to withhold the information from public disclosure since the situation that prompted the submittal required immediate NRC Staff attention.

CYAPCO did commit to submit all the necessary proprietary documents by April 14, 1995. Therefore, included as Attachment 1 of this letter, is a Westinghouse application for withholding proprietary information from public disclosure (CAW-95-800), accompanying affidavit, proprietary information notice and copyright notice.

Also enclosed with this letter are the following items:

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 Engineering Evaluation of Burst/Plugged Tube(s) at Connecticut Yankee (Non-Proprietary).

As item 1 listed above contains information proprietary to Westinghouse Electric Corporation, it is supported by an affidavit signed by Westinghouse, the owner of the information. The affidavit sets forth the basis on which the information may be withheld from public disclosure by the Commission and addresses with specificity the considerations listed in paragraph (b)(4) of Section 2.790 of the Commission's regulations.

Accordingly, CYAPCO respectfully requests that the information which is proprietary to Westinghouse be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10CFR2.790 of the Commission's regulations.
