

ILLINOIS POWER COMPANY Clinton Power Station PERFORMANCE DATA

On February 9, 1994 Dr. D. Grentz, Medical Review Officer recommended that management be notified of a presumptive positive drug test (onsite screening) on an armed security officer. He recommended that the officer be required to disarm or be suspended pending the results of the confirmation test. This individual was disarmed, removed from the protected area and access suspended pending the results of the confirmation test. The confirmation test was positive and access was denied.

No other temporary suspensions or other administrative actions were taken against individuals based on onsite unconfirmed screening positives for marijuana (THC) or for cocaine during this reporting period.

Clinton Power Station continues its observance of the procedures and protocols for onsite laboratory testing for alcohol and illegal drugs conforming to 10CFR26 requirements.

\* Clinton Power Station tests all site employees with and without unescorted access privileges.

\*\* Numbers given reflect testing of those individuals placed on a monitoring program per the Medical Review Officer's (MRO) recommendation due to background information and personal interviews by the MRO. These are unannounced tests, and the individuals are escorted from their jobs to the collection site for testing. Also included in these numbers are those tests which are repeated because of low specific gravity or low creatinine results on the initial urine tests.
