Subject: Qualifications of the Fermi-2 Radiation Protection Manager

In our review of Amendment 51 to your FSAR, we find that there is insufficient information in the description of the qualifications and the professional experience of the newly appointed radiation protection manager (RPM), Mr. W. V. Lipton, who serves in the capacity of General Supervisor-Health Physics. Your description is not specific enough to permit us to determine whether the new RPM's qualifications satisfy the guidelines of Regulatory Guide 1.8, "Personnel Selection and Training." It is our position that based on this regulatory guide, the new RPM should have at least three years of professional working experience in applied radiation protection at a nuclear power plant. This work experience should involve resolving radiological problems similar to those encountered in nuclear power plants, preferably in an actual nuclear power plant.

Accordingly, provide the following additional information: a description of Mr. Lipton's professional experience in applied radiation protection work in a nuclear facility dealing with radiological problems similar to those encountered in nuclear power plants. Your response should contain a detailed description, for each position held, of: (1) the facility and its location; (2) the exact position held; (3) his functions, responsibilities and duties; and (4) the duration of each position.
