SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF NOVEMBER 15, 1983 MEETING ON THE ANALYSES OF THE
STEAM GENERATOR AND REACTOR COOLANT PUMP STRUCTURES, COLT DIESEL
GENERATOR, AND REACTOR COOLANT PUMP SEALS.

On November 15, 1983 members of the staff met with representatives from Kansas Gas and Electric, Union Electric, SNUPPS, Bechtel, and Westinghouse to discuss the subject items. A list of attendees is enclosed.

The meeting began with a presentation from the Bechtel staff on the seismic qualification procedures and an overview of the program status for the diesel generator. Included in this discussion were descriptions of the program itself, the seismic criteria, the test qualification criteria, the analytical qualification criteria, and the current review procedures. During the presentation, the staff requested that the applicants identify the process used to update the diesel generator purchase specifications and how any changes in the specifications were incorporated into the design. The staff further noted that if this information was provided, the response spectra for the building floors were not required.

Next, Westinghouse presented a description of the qualification process used for the reactor coolant pumps (RCPs) and steam generators (SGs). Included in this discussion were presentations on the design requirements, load combinations stress limits, and analytical methods used to analyze the SGs and RCPs. Westinghouse concluded with a discussion on the cartridge RCP seals used in the SNUPPS design which included a description of the material, specification, and tests to which the seals were subjected.
