8 RESOLUTION NO. 142

9 A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MANAGING  
10 DIRECTOR TO IMPLEMENT AN EXTENDED  
11 CONSTRUCTION DELAY OF PROJECT 3.

12 The Managing Director reports that on May 27, 1983, the Executive  
13 Board adopted Resolution No. 147 directing the Managing Director to  
14 submit Bonneville Power Administration's proposal for a three-year  
15 construction delay of Project 3 to the Project 3 Owners' Committee and  
16 directing the Managing Director to implement an immediate construction  
17 slowdown for a period not to exceed 30 days and to continue to make  
18 every effort to obtain financing for continued construction, and that  
19 such proposal was submitted to the Owners' Committee on June 1, 1983,  
20 pursuant to the Project 3 Ownership Agreement, and

21 The Managing Director further reports that on June 24, 1983, the  
22 Executive Board adopted Resolution No. 151, directing the Managing  
23 Director to propose revised Annual and Construction Budgets for Project  
24 3 to the Project 3 Owners' Committee, the Bonneville Power Administration  
25 and the Participants' Review Board, pursuant to the Project 3 Ownership  
26 Agreement, Project Agreement and Net Billing Agreements, which budgets  
27 provide for continued construction of Project 3 on the current approved  
28 cost and schedule and payment of the Supply System's costs of construc-  
29 tion by payments received under the Project 3 Net Billing Agreements,  
30 and that such budgets were submitted on June 27, 1983, and

31 The Managing Director further reports that efforts have been under-  
32 taken to secure either conventional or alternate sources of funding for

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1 continued construction of Project 3, which efforts have not yet been  
2 successful, and that the Managing Director and staff are unaware of any  
3 current source of funds to continue construction of Project 3 and have  
4 no expectation of securing any source of funds within a reasonable time  
5 in order to continue either full or partial construction, and

6 The Managing Director further reports that the Bonneville Power  
7 Administration proposed for a three-year construction delay and the  
8 Supply System's proposal for continued construction of Project 3 on the  
9 current approved cost and schedule have been disapproved by various  
10 parties pursuant to the relevant agreements, and

11 The Managing Director further reports that the funds presently  
12 available to the Supply System, including investment income, for payment  
13 of the costs of construction of Project 3 are insufficient to pay current  
14 commitments together with the additional costs of slowing down construc-  
15 tion and preservation costs. Delay of a decision whether to slow down  
16 construction would worsen the situation without increasing the prospects  
17 of a successful financing, and

18 The Executive Board finds that it is unaware of any current source  
19 of funds for continued full or partial construction of Project 3 and  
20 that it has no expectation of securing any funds within a reasonable  
21 time to continue either full or partial construction, and

22 The Executive Board further finds that it would not be prudent for  
23 the Supply System to continue full or partial construction of Project 3  
24 in the absence of an assured source of funds to pay the costs and expenses  
25 that would thereby be incurred and that it is in the best interests of  
26 the ratepayers to implement an immediate extended construction delay of  
27 Project 3, until an assured source of funds for continued construction  
28 of Project 3 is obtained; AND, THEREFORE,

1 IT IS RESOLVED that the Managing Director is directed to  
2 implement an immediate extended construction delay of Project 3 until an  
3 assured source of funding for continued construction can be obtained and  
4 to prepare and deliver a detailed implementation plan to the Executive  
5 Board consistent with the foregoing, and

6 IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Managing Director is directed to  
7 continue to seek to remove the impediments preventing the Supply System  
8 from financing continued construction of Project 3, and

9 IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Managing Director is directed to  
10 take all necessary steps to resolve the dispute regarding the disapprovals  
11 of the proposed Annual and Construction budgets through the processes  
12 prescribed by the relevant contracts, by agreement, or by litigation, as  
13 appropriate, and to report to the Executive board at its next regular  
14 meeting.
