Gentlemen:

This refers to the Systematic Assessment of Licensee Performance (SALP) of the Arkansas Nuclear One, Units 1 and 2, facility. The SALP Board met on August 16, 1983, to evaluate the performance of the subject facility for the period July 1, 1982, through June 30, 1983. The performance analyses and resulting evaluations were discussed with you at Arkansas Nuclear One on October 14, 1983.

The performance of your facility was evaluated in the selected functional areas identified in Section IV of the enclosed SALP Board Report. The SALP Board evaluation process consists of categorizing performance in each functional area. The categories which we have used to evaluate the performance of your facility are defined in Section II of the enclosed SALP Board Report.

It is my view that Arkansas Power and Light Company's overall regulatory performance at Arkansas Nuclear One is satisfactory. Although there has been some improvement in your performance over the previous SALP period, significant improvement is needed in the areas of fire protection and maintenance. In addition, the effectiveness of the plant safety committee should be improved in the areas of identifying the root causes of problems and consideration of the generic aspects of identified problems.

Your letter of November 3, 1983, which provided comments on the 1982/1983 SALP Board Report, and the SALP Board Report appear as enclosures to this letter which issues the SALP Board Report as an NRC report.

Copies of the enclosed SALP Board Report, our letter of September 29, 1983, your letter of November 3, 1983, and this letter will be placed in the Public Document Room.
