Operating nuclear power plants in the U.S. currently possess the means to record critical plant parameters via the so-called plant process computer. Section 1.8 of NRC's boiling water reactor (BWR) training manual (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System [ADAMS] Accession No. ML11258A297) provides a discussion of the plant process computer. Section 3.7.4 of the Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) for Columbia Generating Station (ADAMS Accession No. ML19343C087) provides information about that site's seismic instrumentation.
