MANPOWER DATA FOR LICENSE FEES

The ACRS professional manpower expended is shown below for the projects listed in your October 2 memorandum.

Please note that the ACRS review was conducted for most of these projects before there was a requirement to keep a close account of manpower expended on projects and we have had to reconstruct most of the data. Further, our professional manpower resources came from several sources, i.e., members, consultants, staff, purchase orders for experts, etc. Accordingly, these are best estimates only. They should be accurate within a factor of 5-10%.
