The WNP 3/5 SALP Review Board for WNP 3/5 is scheduled for July 23, 1981. The attached NRR Performance Evaluation is forwarded in compliance with the above reference.

WNP 3/5 anticipates submitting an OL application with FSAR in late 1983. Construction is scheduled to be completed in late 1985.

NRR correspondence with WNP 3/5 during the current SALP evaluation period has been limited to Quality Assurance Branch, Licensee Qualification Branch, Materials Engineering Branch, Geosciences Branch, and Division of Licensing Generic Letters. The branches were requested to provide input for this evaluation (memorandum attached). QAB, LQB and MEB considered their correspondence with WNP 3/5 to be of such a low volume as to provide no basis for an evaluation. GB responded with the attached evaluation input.

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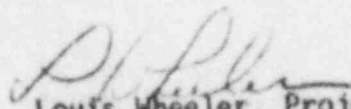

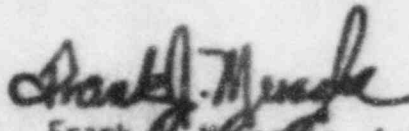
