Subject: Extension No. Two (2) to Letter Contract No. NRC-05-84-151,  
WESTEC/NRC, Entitled "Technical Assistance to Support IE  
Personnel in Integrated Design Inspections"

Pursuant to the terms of the Letter Contract, it is hereby mutually agreed that the definitization date shall be extended from March 20, 1984 to April 12, 1984. The cost ceiling shall remain at \$350,000 and shall represent the maximum liability to the Commission in the event of failure to reach agreement on a definitive contract. In performance of work under this Letter Contract, the Contractor is authorized to incur costs and commitments not to exceed \$350,000 to cover estimated costs of performance. All other terms and conditions of the Letter Contract shall remain in effect.

Enclosed are three copies of this supplemental agreement. The Contractor shall execute all three copies of the agreement, retain one (1) fully executed copy for its own records and return two (2) copies to the Contracting Officer.
