Dear Mr. Ferroggiaro:

This is in response to your letter dated September 10, 1971, addressed to Mr. Richard W. Smith, Director of our Region V office in Berkeley, California, your October 13, 1971 letter to me, and refers to our telephone conversations on September 17, September 20, and October 28, 1971.

As I discussed with you on the telephone, we recently completed an investigation at Pacific Gas and Electric Humboldt Bay nuclear power reactor. This investigation, among other things, covered certain allegations concerning possible unsafe radiation practices and conditions at the reactor site, which you informed us were made by Mr. R. J. Rowen, Jr., to you and to the Humboldt County Grand Jury. I am enclosing for your information a copy of our letter to the Pacific Gas and Electric Company which as a result of this investigation sets forth our citation for two items of noncompliance and our findings with respect to the safety of operations of their Humboldt Bay facility. We are, of course, following up on these items during our periodic inspections to assure that adequate corrective action is taken.

If we can be of further assistance in this matter, please let me know.
